



CHANGES TO DOG LICENSING REQUIREMENTS

On June 22, 2010, Governor Paterson signed a measure into law as part of the 2010-2011 State Budget that moves the remainder of the dog licensing function required by Article 7 of the Agriculture and Markets Law to local governments. In your case, to the **Town of Lysander**

If you currently have a dog that is licensed in the Town of Lysander your next renewal notice will come from the **Lysander Town Clerk's Office** and you will receive a new dog tag.

IF YOU HAVE A DOG THAT IS NOT LICENSED

YOU COULD BE SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN \$25

Under Article 7 of the NYS Agriculture & Market's Law, Section 119 all dogs four months of age or older are to be licensed.

If you currently have a dog that is not licensed you will need to license your dog
