





FEE: Half Day \$60 or Full Day \$90 Optional Fee \$10 for electricity

The large pavilion donated by the Rotary Club of Baldwinsville is located to the right of the playground. Included with your rental fee is 8 picnic tables under the roof and three outside and two charcoal grills. Electricity and water are available for an additional fee.

Half Day rentals are for AM hours from 9 to 2 pm and PM hours which are from 3 to 8 pm. The Pavilions are open and available to the public unless you pay the rental fee ahead of time.

A refundable security deposit of \$25 is charged with your rental fee and is returned the week after your rental when you have left the pavilion free of debris. We provide trash bags for your convenience.
