Mini Movers

This one hour multi-age class will surely tire out YOUR mini mover! Ideal for those beginning to walk and older. Each week has a fun theme and the hour consists of both structured and unstructured play. Children's gross motor and sensory abilities are challenged as they play with their caregivers and peers. Sample activities include tactile exploration with sensory bins and painting with edible materials, obstacle courses, music, and games that all practice skills like jumping, rolling, balancing, climbing, and that promote coordination between both sides of the body. Baby Sensorimotor

This one hour class will make for a memorable family outing with the newest addition to your family. Ideal for your baby until he/she is proficiently crawling. Babies will enjoy a variety of sensorimotor activities while both bonding with their caregivers and exploring socially within the group. Activities will incorporate all of baby's senses as well as the body's sense of movement, positioning, and self regulation. Classes will provide opportunities for tummy/floor time, massage, music/finger plays, as well as independent exploration of age appropriate materials. You and your child will look forward to our weekly hour of playing and learning! The class begins with songs, a read aloud and a gross motor/cooperative activity. Each session we plan age appropriate and seasonal themes in an effort to teach new vocabulary and motivate our learners. Next the children will explore a variety of play stations that strengthen their early literacy and numeracy, fine motor, gross motor, language and sensory abilities. Our dramatic play area, sensory bins, and art projects are always LOVED by our tots and reinforce our weekly theme/learning! The teacher leads one of the play stations and works with your child each week. This class reflects the importance that social skills, preschool and kindergarten readiness skills all be taught naturally through PLAY! Siblings 9 months or younger can attend for free. Siblings older than 9 months that are on the move are asked to check out Mini Movers, as we hope to limit distractions that will take away from our "tot school" fun! 
