**There is an immediate Job Opening for a Motor Equipment Operator (MEO).**

This is a union position that includes benefits such as vacation, personal, sick and compensation time and health benefits in accordance to the union contract. This union position is subject to random drug testing.

### **POSITION REQUIREMENTS:**

The work involves responsibility for the safe and efficient operation of tools, equipment and vehicles. This position requires a Class B CDL license with air brake endorsement, knowledge and experience in equipment handling. This position includes but is not limited to the operation of a dump truck or pick-up truck in connection with snow plowing and hauling of material. This position also includes but not limited to the operation of backhoe/loader, payloader, skid steer, street sweeper, sewer vac, motorized road roller and tractor operation for roadside mowing. Operation of hand tools, lawn mowers, chain saws, pavement/concrete saws, etc. are required. This position includes but not limited to the performing of manual labor such as loading and unloading trucks, digging ditches, cleaning basins, cleaning culverts, shoveling snow, flagging traffic, erecting signs and fences and other duties as requested. Responsible for checking the working condition of equipment and be able to perform routine service, maintenance and repairs. Also, maintains cleanliness of assigned vehicles and the cleanliness of other highway department vehicles, tools and equipment.

### **FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES & PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:**

Good knowledge of traffic laws and other regulations governing the use of motor equipment and of the hazards and safety precautions involved in its operation. Good knowledge of the operation & maintenance of vehicles, equipment and tools. Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions. Ability to work well with others, be dependable, have mechanical aptitude, willingness to respond to emergencies, willingness to work under adverse weather conditions, and physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

Six (6) months of work experience, or its part-time equivalent, in the operation of motor equipment used in construction, repair and maintenance of public works, building construction, or in the operation of large trucks.
