

Use of the courts during the off-season is a temporary privilege granted by the Town of Lysander under provisions agreed upon by the individual when registering with the Parks and Recreation Department as an “OFF-SEASON COURT MEMBER.”

INSTRUCTIONS TO BECOME AN “OFF-SEASON COURT MEMBER:”

OFF-SEASON COURT USE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES:

1. Become an “Off-Season Court Member.” *(REGISTRATION)*
2. Sign-up in advance to play at: tinyurl.com/cnypickleball9. *(RESERVATION)*
3. Call the Town of Lysander Parks & Recreation Department; 315-635-5999, for Gate Code and confirmation of Registration and Reservation.
 - a. PLEASE DISIGNATE **ONE** INDIVIDUAL WITHIN YOUR PLAYING GROUP TO CALL THE PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENT.
 - b. THIS INDIVIDUAL WILL BE YOUR PLAYING GROUP’S “**CAPTAIN.**”
 - c. The “**CAPTAIN**” will be the individual responsible for the Gate, and the condition of the courts, or for passing the responsibility off to the next playing group.
4. Agree to the following:
 - a. I will not share the padlock combination.
 - b. I will lock the courts when I am done playing, or pass the responsibility to the next “**CAPTAIN.**”
 - c. I will use one of the four pickleball lined courts on the tennis courts before using the dedicated pickleball courts.
 - d. I will provide my own net. If I do not have a net, I promise to take full responsibility for and care of the Town provided portable net.
 - e. I will not use the courts unless they are absolutely free of snow.
 - f. I will not make use of a snow shovel in an attempt to clear snow from the courts.
 - g. I fully understand that the off-season use of the pickleball courts is a temporary privilege granted by the Town of Lysander with my agreement and the agreement of each registered “Off-Season Court Member” to the stipulations named in these instructions for off-season court membership.
